- 3. Please remember to check if all your players have photos in play football
- 4. Reminder regarding team lists at grading:

In the past clubs would be aware that players were required to be active for Grading. Now, if a player is active, clubs are required to pay fees to governing bodies regardless if they participate or not. In light of the above, and as per Regulation B9.3 - *B9.3 For Grade 12 and above (except Premier League), all teams must have a minimum of ten (10) players nominated. See the Premier League regulations for team minimums in that division.* Clubs can leave players "pending waiting approval" and provide a list of nominated players for each team at grading.

MPIO course

The Macarthur Football Association will be hosting a Member Protection Information Officer (MPIO) Workshop at Lynwood Park on Monday, 23 March from 6:30pm.

Full MPIO training involves completion of an online training program through Play By The Rules (link here: <u>http://www.playbytherules.net.au/online-courses</u>) and attendance at this workshop.

Although the course is based in Campbelltown, it can be difficult for club to find courses that run close by.

Please take advantage of this opportunity, It is a requirement of Football NSW and endorsed by FFA and Sport Australia for each club to have a MPIO.
