REGISTRATIONS

Age Exemption Request forms

Clubs are required to complete a player exemption request form for any players wishing to play up more than the 2 year age requirement as per regulation A7.1.

One has been attached to your email.

Small Sided Football – Grading

If you have a returning small sided team, please name them the same as 2020 on your grading sheet. If two are merging, note their 2020 team names in the comment's column.

If you have a new small sided team at your club, please give them a number in play football when building the team and on the grading sheet. We will allocate them a colour.

Men's Premier League

Please be reminded, players playing in the Men's Premier League Competition must be registered, active and allocated in play football by the 7/03/2020 to be eligible to play in the 1st Round of the competition.

Photo's

Please check all your photos and ensure they are no more than 12 months old.

They are to be the same as passport photos. Picture of head and shoulders. They cannot have hats or sunglasses. Glasses are permitted if player is playing in safety glasses and has sought clearance for them.
